Safeguarding update (MT)

- There have been no safeguarding incidents since the last committee meeting
- As per British Cycling, all volunteers aged 16 or over regularly working with young people must complete a Safeguarding training course every three years and have a DBS check completed. This includes helpers as well as qualified coaches. New volunteers should register with Mike Tibbits (chairman@malverncyclesport.org.uk) to begin this process.
- All currently registered regularly volunteers who are not up to date have been emailed on 24/06/22 by Mike Tibbits and asked to update their Safeguarding training, first aid training or DBS check as required.
- When completing the DBS check, the name Ashley Wallace (ashleywallace@britishcycling.org.uk) can be inputted as a contact for verifying documents, rather than the Post Office check.
